

To participate in the admission selections to the Masters or Postgraduate Courses, candidates must complete the following procedures by the date set in the notice of the Course:

1. Connect to the University website <http://delphi.uniroma2.it> select STUDENT AREA and then in the order:

A) POST-GRADUATE COURSES> 1) MASTER / ADVANCED COURSES > 1) REGISTRATION TO THE MASTER / ADVANCED COURSES ADMISSION TEST> a) FILL IN THE APPLICATION> select the reference FACULTY and the Master or the Postgraduate course of interest identified with the "COURSE CODE" indicated by the specific announcement. (the code for the master in sonic arts program is PVO). At the end of the compilation of the application, a code called CTRL is released on the screen, of which it is absolutely necessary to take note before proceeding to print the application and the bulletin. This code will help solve any problems that may occur (reprint function and cancellation of the application). If the bulletin is for an amount equal to € 0.00, the completed application must be printed and validated with the AUTH code on the bulletin generated together with the application.

If the call provides for the payment of a (non-refundable) selection contribution, it is necessary to:

2. Make the payment at the Unicredit agencies on the national territory. Use only and exclusively the payment slip generated when registering for the admission competition. It is also possible to pay online by credit card through the UniCredit Banca di Roma website (www.uniroma2.it> Students> Online Student Services> Payment of university fees> Unicredit. Any other amount paid in any other form will not be valid for the purposes of this registration.

3. Reconnect online and validate the payment by also entering the contribution payment codes (CTRL - AUTH) provided by the bank;

It is absolutely essential to complete the validation to participate in the selection

4. Send the admission application, together with the documentation required for the selection, to the addresses of the Didactic Secretariat indicated in the announcement of the Course. If the number of applications exceeds the maximum availability of places indicated in the announcement of the course, admission will take place on the basis of scrolling rankings formulated by the Academic Board. Failure to enroll by the deadline will result in renunciation and subsequent candidates in the ranking will be admitted to the Course.
